Mobility

Movement to a Higher Level:

- An athlete cannot change her level within 3 weeks prior to any open qualifier that she is registered for.
- An athlete may move to a higher level at any other time during the season.
- The athlete's qualifying score for Provincial Championships must be met under the rules of the higher level.

Movement to a Lower Level:

- Athletes can move down a level before 3 weeks prior to their 1st registered competition or within 2 weeks after their 1st registered competition provided they did not compete.
- Athletes may only move down one level per competitive season.

Medical Petitions

Medical petitions will be considered by the Women's Program Committee if **ALL** of the following criteria are met:

- The athlete has exhausted her 4th competition opportunity.
- The athlete was only able to earn an All Around score at 2 of the 4 competitions.
- The athlete has reached her qualifying score once.
- The athlete has a note signed by an MD (Medical Doctor) stating the reason for not competing.
- There is space for the athlete in meets #17 and #18. If no space, but criteria is met, the athlete may request to compete at an out-of-province competition to earn the score. The competition must be using current CPP rules.

Refunds

If an athlete who is registered in the Provincial Qualifying system and does not participate in any of the qualifiers during the entire competitive season, the athlete's club will receive the \$130 refund at the end of the season.

Awards

- Medals (1st to 3rd) and Ribbons (4th to 8th) with No Bumping
- Categories with 25 or more competing athletes in 1 flight will be split for awards.
- Categories will be split by birth date at the ½ way mark of the total athletes to be split.

4th Competitive Opportunity

- A 4th competitive opportunity is available for athletes to achieve the minimum score. The fee is \$50 and is payable to the host club.
- Coaches must complete the necessary form and submit it to Gymnastics Ontario a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the competition.
